A memorable wedding

1. Sealing the Vows

The Problem of Distance - “do not come up” (19:12, 21, 22, 24; 24:2), “worship from afar” (24:1)

How can they live together?

Enter into a Covenant

Committing to obedient fellowship with God “All the LORD has spoken we will do” (19:8, 24:3, 24:7)

Sealed with Blood (Ex 24:8)

Remind yourself of The New Covenant every time you share the Lord’s Supper. (Heb 9:15–20; Matt 26:28)

2. The Reception

The benefit of covenant relationship - intimacy with God.

When you take the Lord’s Supper, imagine receiving the bread and wine as if from the hands of Jesus.
