To Suffer or Duck and Cover - Luke 6:12-26

True disciples think about opposition as...

1. ...an opportunity for boldness (v12-19)

Jesus prays his ministry would grow, (v12) Jesus appoints the Twelve Apostles (v13-16) Jesus' ministry grows (v17-19)

2. ...a blessing (v20-23)

...because of your heavenly reward. ...because you're in good company (the prophets of old v23)

3. ...a warning (v24-26)

Woe to disciples who won't suffer on account of the Son of Man

The four woes correspond to the four blessings

There will be a heavenly reckoning, so be careful to make a good decision

Application

A framework for our decision making – "Which would you rather"

- Be poor now (v2o) OR
- Be hungry now (v21) OR
- Be hated, excluded and insulted now OR
- To suffer on account of Son of Man OR

to be rich now (v24) to be full now (v25) all people speak well of you now (v26) duck & cover

Be careful, there is a future heavenly reckoning. What would it look like for you to be bold when it comes to living out your faith?
