Oppressive rule is broken - like when Gideon defeated the Midianites (Jud 7–8)

The end of wars - weapons (Isa 2:4), now even the clothes (v. 5)

Col 1:13 - from the domain of darkness to the kingdom of the Son

## 2. God has given us a King (vv. 6–7)

The greatest gift - a son who is fully man and fully God.

Wonderful Counsellor (in a world of confusion)
Mighty God (in a world of unbelief)
Everlasting Father (in a world of broken homes)
Prince of Peace (in a world of wars)

Eternal reign of peace, justice and righteousness.
