Compare the Pair: Same ... Same ... Different ...

A New Generation:

1. Whose Reproach has been rolled away (5:2–9)

The previous generation had failed to do the most basic Jewish thing - circumcise their kids. (Gen 17)

Their disobedience was their disgrace (5:6)

A rock stack and a mound of foreskins - God brought us in, God removed our reproach

Jesus rolls back our reproach on the cross and gives us his honour.

2. Who taste God's blessings (5:10–12)

'They ate of the fruit of the land' - 5:11, 5:12 (x2) - The wandering ended

Exodus Generation	New Generation
Came out of Egypt (5:4)	Were born on the way (5:5)
Died in the wilderness (5:4, 6)	Live in the Promised Land (5:1)
Did not obey the LORD (5:6)	Obey the LORD (1:16, 4:10)
Did not see the land (5:6)	Ate the produce of the land (5:11, 12)
Did not circumcise their children (5:5)	Circumcised themselves (5:8)
Reproach of wandering (Num 14:13–16, Deut 9:28)	Honour of entering (5:9)
