"Behold the Lamb of God!"

John 1:19-34, (Pg 886)

When the Support Act outshines the Headliner

John takes every opportunity to direct people to Jesus

1. When people take an interest in John's ministry he points them to Jesus' greatness (vv. 19–28)

Some impressive titles: Christ, Elijah, Prophet

Who are you? The voice, the preparer - the Lord is coming

2. When Jesus arrives on the scene John immediately directs them to Jesus' greatness (vv. 29–34)

Behold the Lamb of God! - clearest explanation of Jesus' ministry.

He ranks before me (v. 30)

The Spirit descended on Him (Isa 61:1)

He baptises with the Holy Spirit (v. 33)

He is the Son of God (v. 34)

Do we want people to know Jesus? Or do we want people to know us?

Jesus and his ministry are far more important than us and ours, so:

- Like John: have a right view of your ministry & service in relation to Jesus
- Like John: Take every opportunity to introduce others to Jesus
