1. In these last days, God has spoken through his Son

2. No other word is in the same league as Jesus

For to which of the	did God ever say, "You are my Son, today I've begotten you"?
When he brings	into the world, he says, "Let all God's angels worship him."
And, "You,	, laid the foundation of the earth in the beginning,
We hear Jesus spe	eaking most clearly in the New Testament

3. Jesus is the last word on salvation.

Don't neglect Jesus, because there are no more salvations coming.
