"Share God's Concern for the Lost"

Jonah 4 (page 774)

Are you right to be angry? (v4, v9)

1. No: Our Anger is Inconsistent.

So angry, he'd rather die than see God let these people live.

Jonah's angry when God's gracious to others, but not when he's the recipient.

Praise God that the Lord is not like us? That it is the LORD who judges us and not Jonah, or you, or me...

2. No: We fail to see God's right concern for Valuable People

Grace in a Plant: God is trying to save Jonah from his sinful attitude

The repetition drives home to us the fickleness of his attitude:

- He wants to die because: the people live (4:3), the plant dies
 (4:8)
- He's angry the people live (4:1), he's angry the plant dies (4:9)

Is it right he's angry (4:4, 9)? God's point: He should be more concerned about the people than the plant.
